## Dalcroze Eurhythmics and Introduction to Piano

The joy of moving the body fosters the learning of musical concepts such as beat, meter, duration, melodic direction, form, phrasing and dynamics. Ear training and improvisation are always incorporated.

Introduction to Piano: the student learns the layout of the keyboard, musical alphabet and simple five finger songs. Musical notation is introduced and improvisation is emphasized.

Director Doina Simovici holds a Master of Arts degree in piano performance from the Conservatory of Music “George Enescu” in Romania, where she performed extensively. In Massachusetts, she has taught for Boston Conservatory, Boston University, Brookline Music School and Walnut Hill School.
